

What is DTMS?

Deep transcranial magnetic stimulation (DTMS) is a revolutionary form of treatment that directly stimulates structures in the brain associated with persistent depression. This noninvasive intervention is effective in treating depression that may not have responded well to other treatments, including medication.

HOW DOES DTMS WORK?

Approved by the FDA, this noninvasive process is delivered through a BrainsWay's patented helmet. Wearing a DTMS helmet for 20-minute sessions, five days per week for six weeks, enables the DTMS treatment to have a maximum effect, enabling the brain to better produce the chemicals that are associated with positive outcomes for one's mood. Deep TMS works by utilizing a magnetic field that manages to directly reach wider and deeper brain regions, regulating the neural activity of brain structures related to depression – specifically the dorsolateral prefrontal cortex (DLPFC). This treatment is offered in an outpatient setting with support of medical and clinical professionals.

HOW EFFECTIVE IS DTMS?

Repeated peer-reviewed studies have found Deep TMS to be a highly effective treatment that can facilitate a profound improvement in patients' mental health, alleviating symptoms of depression and contributing to a significantly greater quality of life. BrainsWay reports that in real-life clinical settings the treatment proven to be effective for three out of four patients, with 51% remission rate and a 75% response rate. As a non-invasive procedure, Deep TMS is also a well-tolerated treatment that usually does not cause any adverse or long-lasting side effects. It does not require a significant recovery period, and the 20-min treatment can easily be integrated into each patient's day-to-day schedule.

Is DTMS Right for You?




Although TMS has minimal and often short-term shine in fact and involves no ingestible ingredients or medications it is important to consult a medical provider to determine if TMS is fit for you. Here are a few points to keep in mind:

- Participants seeking DTMS treatment must be diagnosed with depression.
- Participants must have no history of seizure disorders or a recent episode of a seizure.
- Participants must have no ferromagnetic metal in or around the head (most dental work is safe.)
- People participating in psychotherapy, pharmacotherapy (utilizing medication for depression) and treatment resistant patients may be eligible for the DTMS treatment if those interventions have not been successful in alleviating the depressive symptoms.
- Participants must not be pregnant or nursing.
